THE MOST IMPORTANT CHANGES

A Agriculture, forestry and fishing

- Merging classes 01.63 Post-harvest crop activities and 01.64 Seed processing for propagation
- Creating new group 03.3 Support activities for fishing and aquaculture and new class 03.30 Support activities for fishing and aquaculture

B Mining and quarrying

- divisions, groups and classes have not been changed



THE MOST IMPORTANT CHANGES

C Manufacturing

- Restructuring of division 14 Manufacture of wearing apparel
- Division of group 16.1 Sawmilling and planing of wood; processing and finishing of wood in classes:
 - 16.11 Sawmilling and planing of wood and
 - 16.12 Processing and finishing of wood
- Division of class 16.29 in 3 new classes:
 - 16.26 Manufacture of solid fuels from vegetable biomass
 - 16.27 Finishing of wooden products
 - 16.28 Manufacture of other products of wood and articles of cork, straw and plaiting materials

THE MOST IMPORTANT CHANGES

C Manufacturing

- Division of class 20.59 on:
 - 20.51 Manufacture of liquid biofuels and
 - 20.59 Manufacture of other chemical products n.e.c.
- Merging classes 20.51 Manufacture of explosives, 20.52 Manufacture of glues and 20.53 Manufacture of essential oils in class 20.59 Manufacture of other chemical products n.e.c.
- New class 22.25 Processing and finishing of plastic products

THE MOST IMPORTANT CHANGES

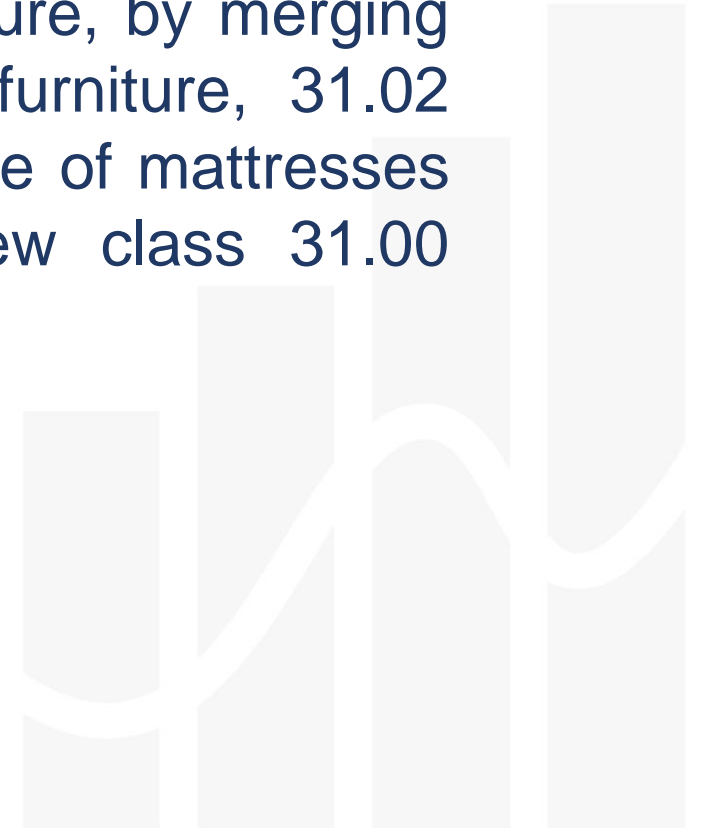
C Manufacturing

- Reorganising the group 25.6 Manufacture of cutlery, tools and general hardware
- Integrating group 26.8 Manufacture of magnetic and optical media in group 26.7 Manufacture of optical instruments and photographic equipment
- New class 28.97 Manufacture of additive manufacturing machinery
- Creating new classes:
 - 30.13 Building of military ships and vessels
 - 30.32 Manufacture of military air and spacecraft and related machinery and
 - 33.18 Repair and maintenance of military fighting vehicles, ships, boats, air and spacecraft

THE MOST IMPORTANT CHANGES

C Manufacturing

- Reorganising the group 31.0 Manufacture of furniture, by merging classes 31.01 Manufacture of office and shop furniture, 31.02 Manufacture of kitchen furniture, 31.03 Manufacture of mattresses and 31.09 Manufacture of other furniture in new class 31.00 Manufacture of furniture



THE MOST IMPORTANT CHANGES

D Electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply

- Reorganising the group 35.1 Electric power generation, transmission and distribution, by creating new classes:
 - 35.11 Production of electricity from non-renewable sources
 - 35.12 Production of electricity from renewable sources and
 - 35.16 Storage of electricity
- New class 35.24 Storage of gas as part of network supply services



THE MOST IMPORTANT CHANGES

E Water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities

- Reorganising the group 38.2 Waste recovery and 38.3 Waste disposal without recovery

F Construction

- Group 41.1 Development of building projects was kicked out, while the class 41.10 Development of building projects has been moved to group 68.1 Real estate activities with own property and development of building projects

THE MOST IMPORTANT CHANGES

G Wholesale and retail trade; repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles

- The main criterion of trade will be based on what is sold and not on sales channels, consequence:
 - Excluded groups 47.8 Retail sale via stalls and markets and 47.9 Retail trade not in stores, stalls or markets
- Division 45 - abolished;
 - wholesale moved in division 46, retail trade in division 47, and maintenance and repair in division 95
- Coverage of the trade is limited to physical goods;
 - Trade of digital goods, download and streaming services are included in section J

THE MOST IMPORTANT CHANGES

G Wholesale and retail trade; repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles

- Merged classes 46.51 Wholesale of computers, computer peripheral equipment and software and 46.52 Wholesale of electronic and telecommunications equipment and parts. The same principle has been applied to retail by merging classes 47.41 Retail sale of computers, peripheral units and software in specialised stores, 47.42 Retail sale of telecommunications equipment in specialised stores and 47.43 Retail sale of audio and video equipment in specialised stores
- Merged classes 47.61 Retail sale of books in specialised stores and 47.63 Retail sale of music and video recordings in specialised stores

THE MOST IMPORTANT CHANGES

H Transportation and storage

- Group 49.1 Passenger rail transport, interurban, has been divided in two classes:
 - 49.11 Passenger heavy rail transport
 - 49.12 Other passenger rail transport
- Group 49.3 Other passenger land transport is reorganised by creating new classes:
 - 49.31 Scheduled passenger transport by road
 - 49.32 Non-scheduled passenger transport by road and
 - 49.34 Passenger transport by cableways and ski lifts



THE MOST IMPORTANT CHANGES

I **Accommodation and food service activities**

- Group 56.1 Restaurants and mobile food service activities has been divided in two classes:
 - 56.11 Restaurant activities
 - 56.12 Mobile food service activities

J **Information and communication**

- Dividing in two new sections:
 - J Publishing, broadcasting, and content production and distribution activities (divisions 58, 59 and 60)
 - K Telecommunication, computer programming, consulting, computing infrastructure and other information service activities (divisions 61, 62 and 63)

THE MOST IMPORTANT CHANGES

K Telecommunication, computer programming, consulting, computing infrastructure and other information service activities


Financial Technology – „Fintech”

- The technology used is not the dominant criterion in defining economic activity, but the type of service provided



THE MOST IMPORTANT CHANGES

L Financial and insurance activities

- Former section K
 - Group 64.2 has been divided in classes:
 - 64.21 Activities of holding companies and
 - 64.22 Activities of financing conduits
 - Group 64.3 has been divided in classes:
 - 64.31 Activities of money market and non-money market investments funds
 - 64.32 Activities of trust, estate and agency accounts

THE MOST IMPORTANT CHANGES

M Real estate activities

- Former section L
- Class 41.10 „Development of building projects“ has been moved in group 68.1 “Real estate activities with own property and development of building projects” (new class 68.12)

N Professional, scientific and technical activities

- Former section M
- Reorganised groups 72.1; classes 72.11 and 72.19 merged in class 72.10 Research and experimental development on natural sciences and engineering
- Class 70.21 has been moved to a new group 73.3 Public relations and communication activities which contains one class 73.30 Public relations and communication activities

THE MOST IMPORTANT CHANGES

N Professional, scientific and technical activities

- Group 74.1 Specialised design activities has been divided in **4** new classes:

74.11 Industrial product and fashion design activities

74.12 Graphic design and visual communication activities

74.13 Interior design activities and

74.14 Other specialised design activities

- Class 74.90 has been divided in two classes:

74.91 Patent brokering and marketing service activities and
residual class

74.99 All other professional, scientific and
technical activities n.e.c.

THE MOST IMPORTANT CHANGES

O Administrative and support service activities

- Former section N
- Content of the class 77.22 Rental of videocassettes and discs is included in the new class 77.22 Rental and leasing of other personal and household goods
- New group has been created 77.5 Intermediation service activities for rental and leasing of tangible goods and non-financial intangible assets:
 - 77.51 Intermediation service activities for rental and leasing of cars, motorhomes and trailers and
 - 77.52 Intermediation service activities for rental and leasing of other tangible goods and non-financial intangible assets

THE MOST IMPORTANT CHANGES

O Administrative and support service activities

- Group 78.3 Other human resources provision is deleted, while its content has been moved to the group 78.2 Temporary employment agency activities and other human resource provisions and class 78.20 Temporary employment agency activities and other human resource provisions
- Groups 80.2 Security systems service activities and 80.3 Investigation activities are integrated into the group 80.0 Investigation and security activities which is also restructured

THE MOST IMPORTANT CHANGES

P Public administration and defence; compulsory social security

- Former section O

Q Education

- Former section P
- The content of this area has been adapted to the new ISCED classification by expanding group 85.3 Secondary and post-secondary non-tertiary education 85.33 Post-secondary non-tertiary education (moved from group 85.4 Tertiary education) and renaming the groups accordingly

THE MOST IMPORTANT CHANGES

R Human health and social work activities

- Former section Q
- Group 86.9 Other human health activities was redefined by dividing it into **8** classes:
 - 86.91 Diagnostic imaging services and medical laboratory activities;
 - 86.92 Patient transportation by ambulance;
 - 86.93 Activities of psychologists and psychotherapists, except medical doctors
 - 86.94 Nursing and midwifery activities;
 - 86.95 Physiotherapy activities;
 - 86.96 Traditional, complementary and alternative medicine activities;
 - 86.97 Intermediation service activities for medical, dental and other human health services
 - 86.99 Other human health activities n.e.c.

THE MOST IMPORTANT CHANGES

S Arts, sports and recreation

- Former section R
- Complete reorganisation of section 90 by defining new groups with associated new classes:
 - 90.1 Arts creation activities
 - 90.2 Activities of performing arts
 - 90.3 Support activities to arts creation and performing arts
- Complete reorganisation of section 91 by defining new groups with associated new classes:
 - 91.1 Library and archive activities
 - 91.2 Museum, collection, historical site and monument activities
 - 91.3 Conservation, restoration and other support activities for cultural heritage
 - 91.4 Botanical and zoological garden and nature reserve activities

- Complete reorganization of section 96 with the raising of previous classes to the level of groups resulting in the definition of new groups:

THE MOST IMPORTANT CHANGES

- For the purposes of displaying the above-mentioned activities **the new groups** have been created:

 - 43.6 Intermediation service activities for specialised construction services
 - 47.9 Intermediation service activities for retail sale
 - 52.3 Intermediation service activities for transportation
 - 53.3 Intermediation service activities for postal and courier activities
 - 55.4 Intermediation service activities for accommodation
 - 61.2 Telecommunication reselling activities and intermediation service activities for telecommunication
