Utility laying chicks are chicks intended to be raised with a view to the production of eggs for consumption

Utility meat chicks (table type chicks) are chicks intended to be fattened and slaughtered before reaching sexual maturity

Utility mixed chicks (dual-purpose chicks) are chicks intended either to be fattened or for the production of eggs for consumption.

Household hatcheries, private commercial hatcheries and industrial hatcheries engaged in the poultry hatching activity.

• Statistical population

Data collection system is based on monitoring and record-keeping of all household hatcheries, private commercial hatcheries and industrial hatcheries engaged in hatching poultry, which are classified in section A Agriculture, Forestry and Fishing, class 01.47, as well as other entities classified elsewhere but engaged in the said activity. The directory of hatcheries has been taken over from the Ministry of Agriculture – Veterinary and Food Safety Directorate.
