Active substances means chemical elements and their compounds as they occur naturally or by manufacture, having general or specific action against harmful organisms or on plants, parts of plants or plant products. Fungicides are products for the extermination of fungi provoking vegetal diseases, including bactericides for extermination of microbes. Herbicides are products for the extermination of weeds or undesirable plants in general. Insecticides are products for the extermination of insects, including acaricides for the extermination of mites. Other pesticides include molluscicides for the extermination of snails, plant growth regulators, vegetal oils, soil sterilants, rodenticides for the extermination of rodents and other plant protection products.
