Hunting year is the period from 1 April of the current year to 31 March of the following year.

Reporting units are legal entities and parts thereof as well as natural persons listed in the records of the Croatian Hunting Federation and the Ministry of Agriculture – Directorate of Forestry, Hunting and Wood Industry.

Reporting units are legal entities and parts thereof as well as natural persons engaged in the activity of breeding, protection, hunting and usage of game and its parts.
