Size category denotes the size class of a hatchery in relation to its total capacity expressed in the number of eggs.

Number denotes the total number of hatcheries within a respective size capacity of a hatchery.

Capacity denotes the maximum number of eggs for hatching that may be placed simultaneously in incubators.

Usage denotes the actual exploitability of incubators in a hatchery in relation to the number of eggs set for hatching during a reference year.

- Statistical units

Household hatcheries, private commercial hatcheries and industrial hatcheries engaged in the poultry hatching activity.

- Statistical population

Data collection system is based on monitoring and record-keeping of all household hatcheries, private commercial hatcheries and industrial hatcheries engaged in hatching poultry, which are classified in section A Agriculture, Forestry and Fishing, class 01.47, as well as other entities classified elsewhere but engaged in the said activity. The directory of hatcheries was taken over from the Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries – Veterinary and Food Safety Directorate.
